We are one team focused on one mission: to help members reach their financial goals. MSGCU continued to grow and reach new milestones due to this focus in 2019.

We welcomed more than 8,000 new members and reached two billion in total assets, all while maintaining a high 96 percent member satisfaction rate. MSGCU was once again named by S&P Global Market Intelligence as one of the top 50 performing credit unions in the United States.

Community and team members celebrated the opening of our fifteenth branch in Commerce Township, as well as completed renovations to our Hall Road branch. MSGCU team members diligently worked throughout 2019 to prepare for the spring 2020 Online and Mobile Banking conversion. This upgrade will give members a state-of-the-art digital banking experience while ensuring we continue to serve our members in the location they prefer, either at a physical branch or virtually.

MSGCU remains proud to support our local organizations and the people who live in our communities. We donated more than \$25,000 to the community and team members volunteered more than 3,000 hours. We awarded more than \$106,000 to deserving scholarship recipients and \$51,000 in grants to teachers via our Classroom Cash Grants program.

We were humbled to receive three recent credit union industry awards for our furlough assistance programs, adult financial education, and student financial reality fairs.

In addition, our commitment to building a strong team is reflected in MSGCU being named a Top Workplace in Michigan for the seventh year in a row. We welcomed 65 new team members to MSGCU in 2019. 




