
Using MSGCU's Online Banking

SETTING UP ALERTS

DESKTOP INSTRUCTIONS



Select Manage Alerts from the Messages and Alerts tab.

Log in. In the blue menu on the left, scroll to Messages and Alerts and click **Manage Alerts** from the drop down menu.



You can set alerts for each account.

You can set up email, text alerts or push notifications to your MSGCU Mobile App (if downloaded). If you don't have a mobile phone added, you can add one here.

Choose the account you'd like to set an alert for.

For example, you can set up an alert if your checking account goes below \$100. First, select the account named Checking. The blue bar next to the name indicates the alerts will be related to that account.



Select Balance Alert. Then select Add another Balance Alert.

Set up your alert.

Since the example is to receive an alert when the checking account goes below \$100.00, we'll select **Below** and then add in 100.00 to the text box. Choose if you want an email, push notification or text message. Select **Save Changes**. While the example is \$100.00, you may choose any amount you'd like.
