

Good news regarding funds availability.

Effective July 1, 2025, our Funds Availability Policy Disclosure will have two beneficial changes for check holds. The next day availability will increase from \$225 to \$275. The amount available for withdrawal on exception holds for large deposits and new accounts will increase from \$5,525 to \$6,725.
