MAKE YOUR PROMISE FOR ONLINE SAFETY



Parents, teachers and other trusted adults are always looking out for your safety, and that includes online. While adults are here to help, it's important for you to keep your information safe. Here's an idea: write a pledge that outlines what you will do to stay safe online. A pledge is a promise. It's like a pinky-swear you write down. Here are some ideas you might want to include.

- I will not share information about myself or my family with anyone online. That includes my name, address, phone number, school name, family member names, where they work, and any other personal information I may be asked for.
- I will never give anyone my passwords, even my best friend.
- I know there may be unfamiliar people who might try to be my friend online. I will ignore them and tell an adult. I will never meet them in person.
- I will not spend money online without asking my parents or guardian.
- I will only fill out online forms or questionnaires after I get the okay from my parent or guardian.
- I will always ask my parent or guardian before I post or send photos and videos online, in texts, or regular mail.
