

Pumpkin Apple Stamps

Materials you'll need:

- Apples
- Paper towel
- Cutting board
- Knife (for an adult to use)
- Paper plates
- Orange paint
- Green paint
- Small paint brush
- White paper

Step 1: An adult will cut the apples in half and dry the inside and outside with a paper towel.

Step 2: On one paper plate, squirt some orange paint. Add some green paint to a separate plate.

Step 3: Dip the inside of the apple in orange paint and make sure it's completely covered in paint. Then stamp on your white paper.

Step 4: Repeat step 3 until you've stamped a few pumpkins on your paper!

Step 5: Using the paint brush and green paint, add a leaf and stem to the top of your pumpkins.

Step 6: You're all done! Let your pumpkins dry and hang up your masterpiece on the refrigerator for your family to see.

Optional step: Once the pumpkins are dry, use a black marker to draw faces on each one and turn them into jack-o-lanterns!
