Grow your savings with the new Youth Flex CD

Happy New Year! It's a great time to plan for building your savings account in 2026 and beyond. Setting money aside now can help you in the future, like when you are ready to go to college or buy your first car when you're older. To help you grow your savings, MSGCU now offers the Youth Flex CD, which is specially designed for our members ages 17 and under. It earns interest at a higher rate than your savings account, which means your money actually makes more money! Open with \$100 or more and the CD stays open for 12 months (that's called the "term"). Here are more ideas to help you save this year:

- ★ **Set a goal.** Having a goal in mind will give you something to work toward. To stay on track, you can even break it down to a monthly savings goal. For example, if you'd like to save \$120 this year, target to add \$10 each month to your savings.
- ★ **Talk about getting an allowance.** Earn some cash to save since money trees don't grow in your backyard (what a bummer!). Ask your parents about what you can do to earn an allowance and tuck that money in your savings.
- ★ **Make deposits.** If you receive money for your birthday, a holiday, or for doing chores – make a deposit to your MSGCU savings account.
