MONEY SCAMS ABOUND! Don't be a victim.

It seems like it's getting harder and harder to keep track of all the scams in the world. And unfortunately, scammers often target teens and young adults specifically. So in future issues of this newsletter, we'll focus on specific scams, and tell you how to thwart the bad actors behind them. We're starting with some key tips from security experts at MSGCU that can protect you, no matter the scam.



- Never give out your Online or Mobile Banking username and password. Ever. Not even to close friends.
- Don't write your ATM personal identification number (PIN) on the card, or share it with anyone.
- Don't let someone borrow your ATM card.
- Don't cash a check for anyone or dispute a charge you know is legit.
- If it seems too good to be true, it likely is.
- Stay vigilant always, and especially on social media. People generally don't contact you out of the blue to give you money. It's likely a scammer phishing for your information or someone taking advantage of you. Not a true friend.
- If you're ever unsure about a situation, always talk to your parent or guardian.

Remember, MSGCU will NEVER ask for your account login password, PIN, or log-in verification code. If you believe you've been a victim of fraud or a scam, contact us immediately.
