

SCHOLARSHIP SPOTLIGHT



With our roots in education, MSGCU is proud to award more than \$100,000 in educational support every year to deserving individuals in our communities. This year's online application period runs until March 1 at msgcuscholarships.org. MSGCU offers several scholarships to fit the needs of many students.

- The Educational Solutions Scholarship is designed for any high school senior planning to attend a university, college, or technical campus. Eighteen \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded.
- The Milo Perreault Educator Advantage Scholarship supports lifelong learning for teachers and administrators. Milo Perreault was a longtime MSGCU Board member and 40-year educator who inspired countless students during his career. Four \$2,500 scholarships will help fund continuing education for recipients.
- The William Cayen Skilled Trades Scholarship helps fund certificate programs in engineering, manufacturing, or other industrial and advanced technologies with two \$2,500 scholarships. William Cayen, a retired educator devoted to helping students follow their passions, especially in skilled trades, currently serves as Chairman of MSGCU's Board of Directors.
- The Rudolph Heino High School Scholarship supports high school seniors who strive to inspire and lead others. The \$2,500 scholarship given to five individuals is named for former MSGCU Board member Rudolph Heino, who always advocated for the credit union philosophy of people helping people.
- The Larry Swantek Educational Studies Scholarship is named for former MSGCU Board member Larry Swantek, a 25-year teacher who influenced students in and out of the classroom. Four \$2,500 scholarships help high school seniors and college students planning to major in education.
- The Stephen Thomas First Responder Scholarship awards \$2,000 each to 12 students enrolled in fire and police programs at Macomb Community, Oakland Community, and Schoolcraft Colleges. Stephen Thomas was a longtime Board member who served as a Sergeant in the Macomb County Sheriff's Department.

Also new this year for members, H&R Block is offering \$25 off for new customers or free Tax Identity Shield (\$35 value) for returning customers.

MSGCU is excited to offer an even more convenient experience when visiting our branch offices. The next time you want to sit down with a team member, you will love the new services.

Coming soon: advance appointments minimize the wait.

Soon, you will have the option to schedule an appointment up to a week prior to your visit. Once available, when you arrive to your chosen branch office, you'll be able to check-in from your smartphone or by using our lobby tablet to let our friendly team members know you've arrived.

New sign in system for walk-ins keeps you updated on your place in line.

Stop into any branch at your convenience. When you arrive, simply sign in for service at the tablet near the door. Or, use your smartphone for a contactless sign-in experience by scanning the QR code or sending a text to the phone number posted in the lobby. This will let team members know you're here and you will receive updates with your place in line. Then, feel free to enjoy a warm cup of coffee in the lobby or even wait in your car. We'll send you a text when it's your turn.
